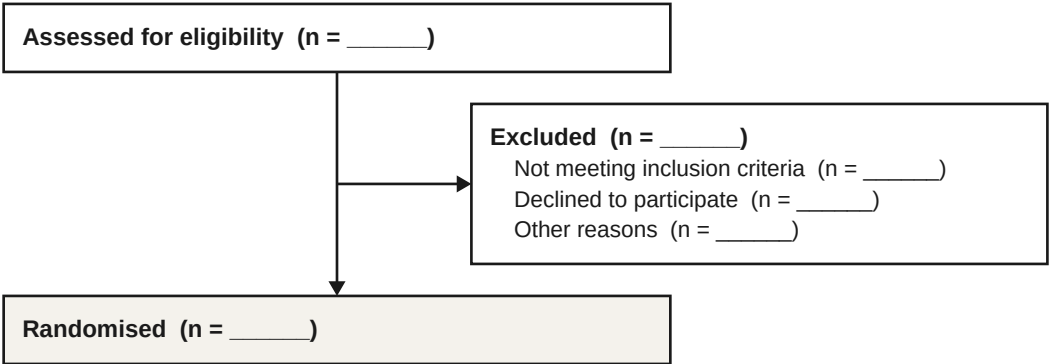


CONSORT Flow Diagram — fill-in template

Participant flow for a two-arm randomised trial, per CONSORT 2025 item on participant flow. Add arms as needed.

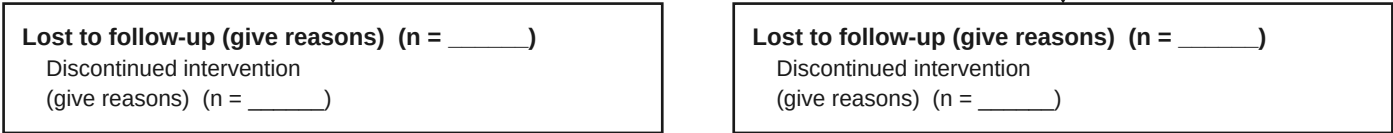

WHAT REVIEWERS CHECK FIRST

Counts must reconcile. Everyone assessed appears exactly once below: assessed = excluded + randomised, and each arm's allocated n flows through follow-up into analysis. A diagram that does not add up is read as a trial that does not add up. Reasons, not just numbers. Every exclusion, loss, and discontinuation carries a reason — "n = 12 lost" alone is a red flag. Analysed n = your results tables. The analysis boxes must match the denominators reported for the primary outcome, and the analysis population (intention-to-treat, modified ITT, per-protocol) should be named in the box or its caption.
